POSITION SUMMARY:

If you've ever attended a church worship service and thought to yourself, "wouldn't it be cool if they did ____ on a Sunday?" we would love to try it out. We want to authentically meet with God every Sunday together and we want to do a better job introducing people to him. While our regular Sunday service structure will feel familiar if you have been a part of non-denominational church culture the past 30 years, we want your giftings and passion to help us explore new ways of truly encountering God together, such as through Scripture reading, corporate prayer, call and response, silence, service, and other elements, in addition to music. You will join an all-volunteer team with a rotating weekly worship leader. You will join this rotation to lead our church in worship about once a month. This position will help you develop a practical philosophy of worship and would benefit you most if you either envision yourself leading worship at a church or leading a church in the future.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Healthy relationship with Jesus
- Desire to learn and grow in knowledge and experience with God
- Willingness to learn and submit to others on a team
- Agreement with our beliefs

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend weekly Sunday service and lead worship team once a month
- Participate on volunteer worship team
- Participate in weekly rehearsals at least twice a month
- Meet with Lead Pastor weekly
- Join weekly staff meetings at least twice a month
- Research and lead our congregation in new ways to meet with God
- Engage our congregation so we all are participating in worship on Sundays
- Learn new roles as necessary (sound, lights, video, instruments, ProPresenter, etc.) to support the team
- During the hiring process, we will work with you to develop specific learning objectives and tailor your role to your particular gifts, passions, and future ministry goals.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
