RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Youth Ministry Resident will be responsible for facilitating youth gatherings on Friday nights and Sunday mornings before service. This individual will work closely with the Youth Ministry team (church stakeholders, parents, and existing volunteers).

Additionally, the Resident will be responsible for the following:

- Disciple and build relationships with students
 - Meet with students outside of large group activities as time allows (online, in-person)
- Establish regular rhythms of communication with both students and their parents
- Coordinate youth group activities and showings for annual church special events
- Support curriculum design, volunteer recruitment, and issue resolution with the Youth Ministry team

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
- This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
 Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee but works under close observation;
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
- 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
