RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Student Ministry Resident is responsible for leading our middle and high school student ministry. This includes:

- Overseeing NDC Students midweek youth group gathering
- Investing in the individual lives of students and their parents
- Planning and executing student events
- Inspiring, equipping, and supporting student ministry volunteers
- Working with our Family Ministries Pastor and helping lead church-wide initiatives and programming

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 - 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
