OVERVIEW:

As a High School Ministry Resident, you would report to the Student and Family Ministries Pastor and the Director of High School Ministry. You would help shepherd our high school students by walking with them in their daily lives and helping implement the programmatic elements of the ministry (weekly programming, retreats, and mission trips, etc.).

We have a desire to bless students, but also be a blessing to you. We strive to give you opportunities to exercise and grow the gifts the Lord as given you as well as being a safe and gracious place to grow spiritually and personally.

RESPONSILITIES:

- Assist the Director of High School Ministry in the total high school program:
 - Carrying out of the philosophy, goals, and objectives of the high school program.
 - Planning, organizing, and conducting regular weekly meetings and special activities such as retreats, mission trips, day outings, etc.
 - Assist in promotion
 - Create and organize skits

- Call students
- Write letters and notes
- Set up/take down rooms
- Coordinate collection of materials needed for program
- Organize and conduct games and recreation for activities and camps
- Teach in both formal and informal settings
- Encourage and direct lay and student involvement in ministry teams
- Contact students:
 - Disciple high school students
 - Attend high school activities
 - Meet with students outside of church and in small groups
 - Participate with students in outside "fun" activities such as sports, entertainment, etc.
 - o Call and write letters and notes
- Participate in teaching opportunities:
 - Teach designated Sunday morning large group meetings
 - Lead small group discussions or Bible studies
- Complete study requirements:
 - Complete assigned readings of books and periodicals
 - Prepare for teaching opportunities

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
- 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
