JOB DESCRIPTION:

The purpose of this position is to develop a relational-based Student Ministry with a two-pronged approach: attracting students to explore a relationship with Jesus and guiding students to grow deeper in their relationship with Jesus. This position also has the potential for preaching and teaching opportunities for the entire church body. The ideal starting date is early March 2024.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Student Ministry

- Invest in relationships with students and parents.
- Direct all Student Ministry programming, including weekly gatherings and occasional events.
- Recruit and train volunteers to engage in developing relationships and discipling the students.
- Develop outreach opportunities for students to invite their un-churched friends.
- Provide resources to students and parents for spiritual, emotional, and mental maturation.

Church-Wide Ministry

- Participate in designated meetings.
- Complete designated assignments, evaluations, and follow-up.
- Provide pastoral care to the body of Christ at South Sub Church.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Effective at multi-tasking, time management, and follow-up.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- 3 years of related work experience preferred.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
- 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
