QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. A growing relationship with Jesus and a love for His church
- B. A heart that is humble and a desire to give to God's people in love, service, and care.
- C. A willingness to be always learning and growing in emotional and spiritual maturity.
- D. A love for caring ministry and ministering to those in need at CCPC.
- E. One who holds to theological essentials rooted in scripture, but who gives liberty in the non-essentials.
- F. A desire to be mentored by pastors and staff in the development of both character and ministry skills.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Funeral and Memorial Services: Assist Pastor of Shepherding Ministries in implementing funeral and memorial services for congregants of Cherry Creek and community members, including the following duties:
 - Attending funeral/memorial service planning meetings.
 - Helping implement a families' wishes for their loved one's service.

- Participating in funeral/memorial services as agreed upon with the Pastor of Shepherding Ministries.
- Providing pastoral care to individuals and families, during and beyond the funeral/memorial service process.
- B. Visitation Team: Assist Pastor of Shepherding Ministries in the following duties related to congregant visitation:
 - Providing Christ-like, emotional and spiritual care to the needs of the CCPC congregation, as agreed upon with the Pastor of Shepherding Ministries.
 - Making phone calls and visits to congregants in hospitals, rehab, etc. as agreed upon with the Pastor of Shepherding Ministries.
 - Promoting Stephen Ministry program and working with Pastor of Shepherding Ministries to refer those in need of care to a volunteer Stephen Minister.
 - Helping implement periodic Stephen Ministry training courses.
 - o Running and making volunteer assignments to homebound visitation team.
 - Helping implement homebound visitation team projects
 - Working with Pastor of Shepherding Ministries in overseeing deacon's visitation team
- C. Pacesetters Seniors Ministry: Assist in helping run the Pacesetters Seniors (55+) Ministry, including the following duties:
 - o Planning, implementing, and running monthly 3rd Friday luncheon.
 - Helping plan each semester's schedule of events.
 - o Providing emotional, spiritual, and mental care to those in the ministry.
 - Establishing intergenerational connections.
- D. Deacons: Assist Pastor of Shepherding Ministries in overseeing the Cherry Creek Deacons and their various roles and responsibilities as needed.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
- 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
