RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend weekly Staff Meeting (Tuesdays 8:30–10:00 a.m.)
- Attend required weekly Ministry Foundations classes (Wednesdays 8:30–10:00 a.m.)
- Meet weekly with Ministry Supervisor, Children and Family Ministry Director
- Maintain scheduled weekly in-office hours (flexible)
- Support the work of Children and Family Ministries by:
 - Serving on Sunday mornings in Fellowship Kids Classes
 - Evaluating and implementing curriculum
 - Assisting with the upkeep of facilities and supplies
 - Helping plan and execute programs and events
 - Participating in volunteer training, support, and appreciation
 - Proactively resourcing and caring for families

 Assisting with other church-wide special services and events such as Advent, Holy Week, et al.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
- 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
