JOB SUMMARY:

We are seeking applicants who have a personal relationship with God, a love for local church ministry, and a desire to gain practical ministry experience.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend weekly Staff Meeting (Tuesdays 8:30–10:00 a.m.)
- Attend required weekly Ministry Foundations classes (Wednesdays 8:30–10:00 a.m.)
- Meet weekly with Ministry Supervisor, Worship and Arts Pastor
- Maintain scheduled weekly in-office hours (flexible)
- Support the work of the Worship and Arts Ministry by:
 - Writing liturgical elements for Sunday services
 - Serving in a band and leading worship for Sunday services
 - Assisting with the upkeep of the art gallery, including show openings and closings
 - Assisting with planning and execution of Worship and Arts programs and events

- Participating in volunteer discipleship, appreciation, and investment
- Assisting with volunteer scheduling
- Assisting with other church-wide special services and events such as Advent, Holy Week, et al.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

1. *Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;*
2. *This training is for the benefit of the trainee;*
3. *Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;*
4. *This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;*
5. *Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;*
6. *Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.*
