The Why: As a Denver Seminary student, this residency provides practical experience in church ministry, gives you a context to put your learning into practice, and helps Arise in its mission to help people follow Jesus.

Roles and Responsibilities

Assist in Student Ministry Leadership:

- Assist the Associate Pastor in the leadership, vision, and execution of Turbulence Student Ministry
- Help plan series, programming, and events for the student ministry
- Actively participate in Wednesday night student ministry gatherings and lead a small group
- Attend and participate in student ministry events
- Plan and give a message at Turbulence at least monthly
- Be a point person for student ministry on Sunday mornings

Administrative Support:

- Manage the administrative tasks for the student ministry including database management, logistics, social media, and communication with students and parents
- Assist in coordinating student ministry events and camps (Winter Camp in January/February and Summer Camp in June)
- Jump into help with all-hands-on-deck events (Christmas Eve, Easter, Shine Awards, etc.).
- Perform all other duties as assigned by the Associate Pastor

Ministry Equipping:

- Meet weekly in 1:1 with the Associate Pastor for training, development, and integration of seminary studies into ministry work
- Read and discuss one book with other residents at monthly Ministry Development meetings
- Attend weekly all-staff meetings (Monday afternoons)
