QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. A growing relationship with Jesus and a love for His church
- B. A heart that is humble and a desire to give to God's people in love, service, and care.
- C. A willingness to be always learning and growing in emotional and spiritual maturity.
- D. A love for students and a desire to engage relationally with them.
- E. One who holds to theological essentials rooted in Scripture but who gives liberty in the non-essentials.
- F. A desire to be mentored by pastors and staff in the development of both character and ministry skills.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Assisting the Director of Middle School Ministry in the total middle school program:
 - 1. Carrying out of the philosophy, goals, and objectives of the middle school program.
 - 2. Planning, organizing, and conducting regular weekly meetings and special activities such as retreats, mission trips, day outings, etc. Such responsibilities include:
 - a. Leading small groups
 - b. Teaching in both formal and informal settings
 - c. Coordinating collection of materials needed for program
 - d. Organizing and conducting games and recreation for activities and camps
 - e. Leading worship (if so gifted)
 - f. Encouraging and directing lay and student involvement in ministry teams
- **B.** Contacting Students
 - 1. Discipling middle school students
 - 2. Attending middle school activities
 - 3. Meeting with students outside of church and in small groups
 - 4. Participating with students in outside "fun" activities such as sports, entertainment, etc.
 - 5. Calling and writing letters and notes
- C. Participating in teaching opportunities:
 - 1. Teaching designated Wednesday Night large group meetings
 - 2. Leading small group discussions or Bible Studies

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition, the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee but works under close observation;
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
- 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
