POSITION SUMMARY: This ministry comprises families with children K4 through 5th grade. We believe that children are not just the church of the future. They are the church of the present. QUALIFICATIONS:

Personal Discipleship:

- Must be committed to a growing personal relationship with Christ
- Value corporate worship and Christian community in personal discipleship
- Invest in healthy relationships with family and friends
- Commit to spiritual and ministry growth through the engagement of good spiritual disciplines: prayer, the study of God's word, Christian fellowship, the exercise of one's giftings, etc.

Key Responsibilities:

Be the primary teacher and pastoral presence for our children:

- Oversee the smooth running of the children's part of the Sunday service (including the registration, safety protocols, teaching, etc.)
- Provide support for the volunteer-run children's Sunday School hour on Sundays
- Welcome families with children. Connect with the families relationally.
- Engage, excite, and equip volunteers for this ministry
- Support parents by resourcing them with relevant, beneficial materials for the discipleship of their children
- Plan occasional events to benefit parents
- Use the church's communication avenues to excite the church about the children's ministry

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree
- Two years of experience in a children's discipleship ministry
- A clear testimony of humble and vibrant faith in the Lord Jesus Christ

Desired Strengths:

- A passion for Christian discipleship, and especially the shepherding of young people
- Ability to take biblical principles and translate them for young people in a relevant way
- Enjoys and encourages a fun environment in the ministry

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an internship and contains the following:

- 1. Supportive ministry training similar to that available in and through schooling for future clergy.
- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee.
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee but works under close observation.
- 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer.
- 5. Participation in this program does not entitle trainees to future employment with the participating ministry.
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
