A third foundational course or approved elective</li> <li>c. Four required track courses</li> <li>d. Three credits of mentored formation</li> <li>e. Nine credits of thesis</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. All Doctor of Ministry students are required to complete a doctoral thesis and participate in an oral defense of that thesis.</li> <li>3. A minimum of 33 hours are required for the degree.</li> </ol>
