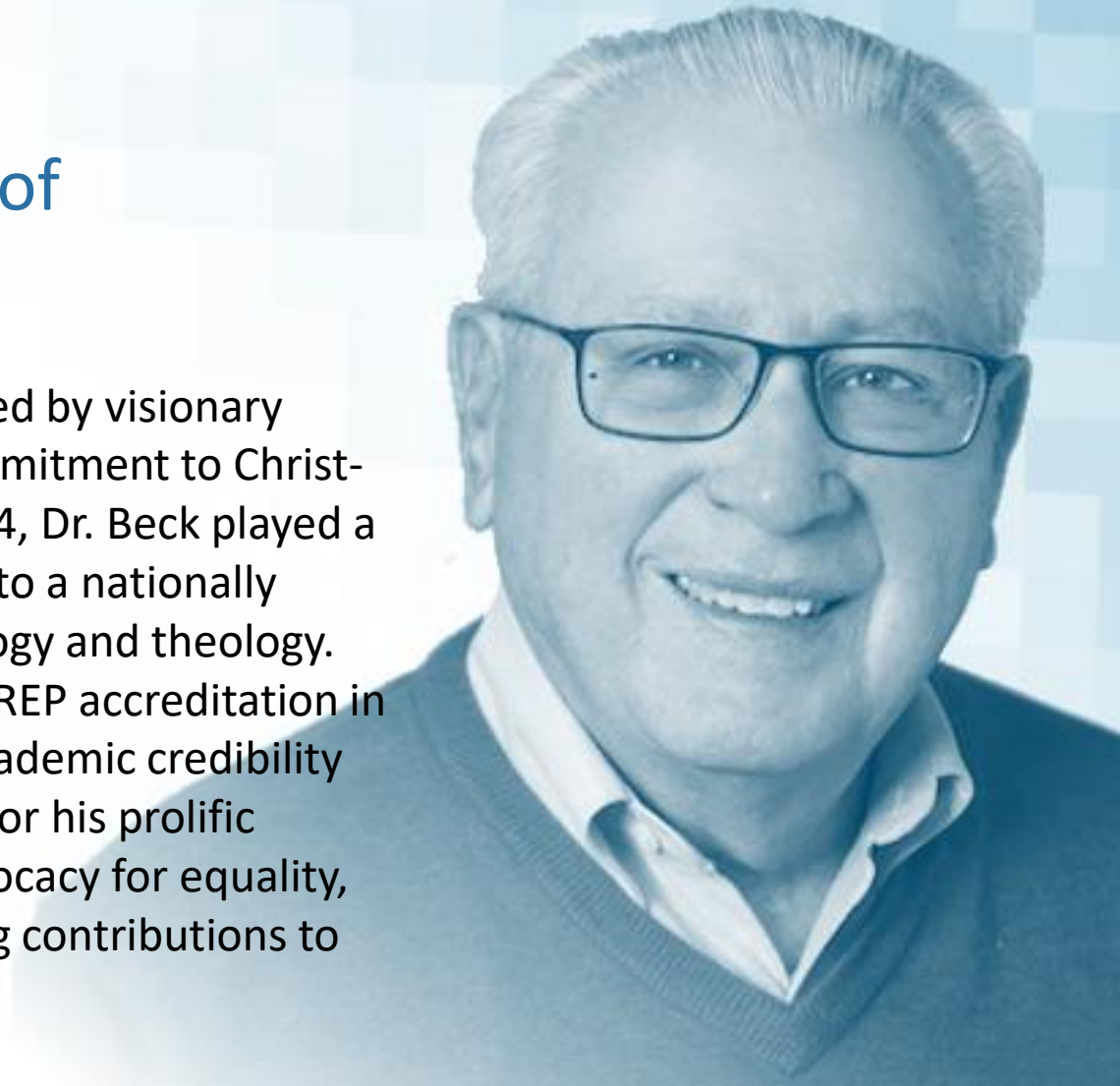

## Honoring the Contributions of **Dr. James R. Beck**

**Dr. Jim Beck's** legacy at Denver Seminary is marked by visionary leadership, academic excellence, and a deep commitment to Christ-centered counseling. Joining the Seminary in 1984, Dr. Beck played a pivotal role in shaping the Counseling Program into a nationally respected model of integration between psychology and theology. His leadership was instrumental in achieving CACREP accreditation in 1997, a milestone that elevated the program's academic credibility and opened doors for future counselors. Known for his prolific scholarship, compassionate mentorship, and advocacy for equality, Dr. Beck continues to inspire through his enduring contributions to the Seminary community and beyond.

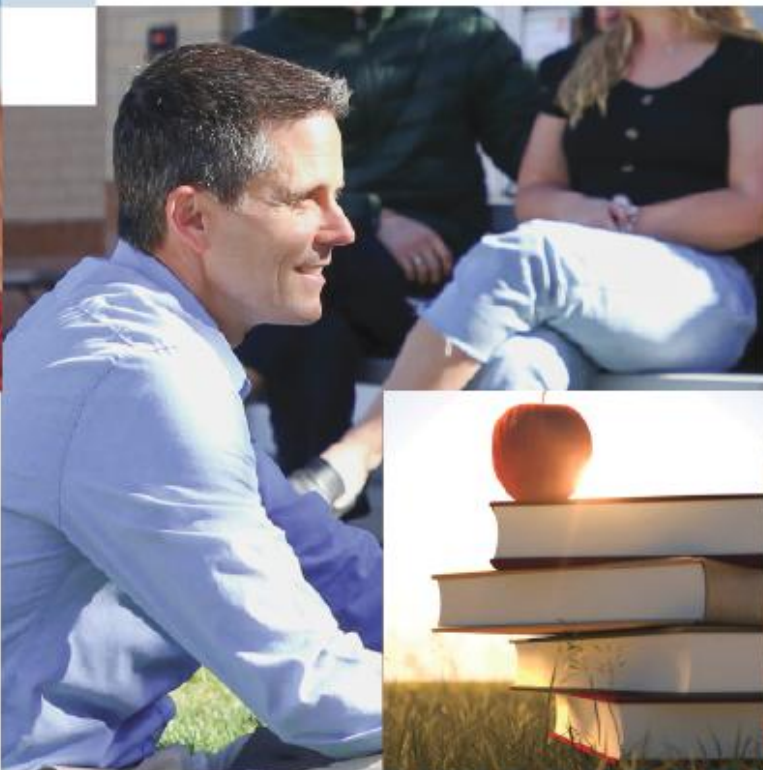
