**DR. MARK HUSBANDS** President

Dr. Mark Husbands serves as the eighth president of Denver Seminary, bringing a distinguished career in Christian higher education, theological scholarship, and institutional leadership. An accomplished theologian, he specializes in Christian doctrine, historical and moral theology, and the intersection of faith and public life.

Dr. Husbands earned his PhD in Christian Theology from the University of St. Michael's College (University of Toronto), where he studied under renowned heologian John Webster, focusing on Karl Barth's ethics of prayer. He also holds an MA in Theology from Wycliffe College (University of Toronto) and a BA in Religious Studies with a minor in Music Performance from York University.

Most recently, he was President and Vice-Chancellor of Trinity Western University, where he strengthened the university's global impact in Christian higher education, eliminated bank debt, raised \$55 million in philanthropy, increased enrollment, and developed a strategic vision centered on Christ-centered, student-focused education.

Prior to TWU, Dr. Husbands served as Vice President for Academic Affairs at Northwestern College, leading significant academic and institutional advancements. He also held the Leonard and Marjorie Maas Chair of Reformed Theology at Hope College, where he founded the Emmaus Scholars Program, fostering integral mission, racial reconciliation, and community development. He has taught theology at Wheaton College and Tyndale Seminary, where he also served as Director of Extension and Summer School.

Dr. Husbands has authored and edited multiple volumes and published numerous scholarly articles on theology, ethics, and World Christianity. His leadership is marked by an unwavering commitment to Christ, the authority of Scripture, and academic excellence. He is dedicated to equipping students to connect their faith with the world's deepest needs. He and his wife, Rebekah, have three adult children, Olivia, Elliott, and Ethan.
