Commencement Speaker

John Moreland, DMin Adjunct Faculty Director of Black Church Programs



Dr. John Moreland was born and raised in the deep traditions of South Texas. He felt called to the lifelong service of Christian ministry at the age of 5, entered public preaching ministry at age 15, and was ordained at age 18. In 2007, Pastor Moreland was called as the Senior Pastor of Lowry Community Christian Church.

After 5 years of faithful service, he and his wife, Kenna, were led to plant Denver Christian Bible Church, where John faithfully served as the Senior Pastor for 10 years, before following the Lord's call into academic ministry.

As an Air Force veteran of 27 years, John has served as a member of Active Duty, Air Force Reserves and the Air National Guard. Major Moreland is a combat veteran, 3-time graduated Squadron Commander, and currently serves as the Deputy Commander of the 140th Mission Support Group, providing leadership to approximately 400 Airmen in the Security, Law Enforcement, Civil Engineering, Logistics and Communications career fields. Notably, John served as the Colorado Task Force Commander for Presidential Inauguration 59—the single largest mobilization of National Guard Forces in American History, to preserve the peaceful transfer of power, after the insurrection of January 6.

Dr. Moreland is the Director of Black Church Programs at Denver Seminary. He leads the Lay Ministry Certificate Program for the Littleton, Colorado and Washington DC campuses of the institution. Additionally, in his role as the Director of the Urban Track, Lilly Grant, he is the principal researcher to establish sustainable pathways in theological higher education for Black students.

John has earned degrees from Wayland Baptist University (Criminal Justice), Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary (Master of Divinity) and Denver Seminary (Doctor of Ministry). Dr. Moreland also completed advanced graduate training at Georgetown University.


Veronica Clark
