Degree Requirements

1. All PhD students are required to complete the comprehensive exam, with a score of 80% or higher, and participate in an oral defense of that exam.
2. All PhD students are required to complete a doctoral dissertation and participate in an oral defense of that dissertation. Students must have successfully passed a minimum of 15 credits in dissertation (CO 4000, 4100, and CO 4200) before the defense.
3. A minimum of 66 hours are required for the degree.
4. Satisfactory completion of Personal Formation requirements during Practicum, Internship I, and Internship II.
5. Students who do not hold a professional counseling license (e.g., LPC) by the start of CO 2210 must select CO 3410 for one of their internship options.
6. Students' total internships must cover at least three of the five doctoral core areas (counseling, teaching, supervision, research and scholarship, leadership, and advocacy). This will total a minimum of 600 hours over the course of four semesters.
